Kay Turnbaugh, will give a slide show and talk about her recently published local history book "Around Nederland". Nederland survived three boom-and-bust cycles involving three different minerals: silver, gold and tungsten. In each boom, men came to mine, open stores, and transport goods and ore. They brought families with them, and many towns sprang up, including Caribou, Eldora, Lakewood, Tungsten, and Rollinsville. Learn about the early days of this unique mining town just up the canyon from Boulder.

Author Kay Turnbaugh has a deep-rooted love for local history, owning Nederland's weekly paper, the Mountain-ear, for nearly 20 years and also writing "The Last of the Wild West Cowgirls" a biography of Goldie Griffith. Copies of Kay's book will also be for sale after the presentation.
